I would like to pick out a few exhibits for special mention & these are TANNER-MASON'S MENTOBE LITTLE-MISCHIEVOUS. SBI n. HENSON'S SPHYNXALIENS ROCKY ROAD. SPH n 21. DMYTRIYEVA'S DOBSHANGRILA GOLDIE. BEN n 24. SLUITERS'S TARA GR CH & TARA GR PR ALDEBIZ GINCHIKARA. BUR c. all were worthy winners.

Birman Grand Champion, Male;

GR CH Not Awarded. 1st TANNER-MASON'S CH CARRICKFERN JIGOLO. SBI a. 30-05-10. Blue Point, this lad was badly out of coat & suffered badly as a result. His head has good width across the cheeks, but a little fine on the muzzle, rounded skull, slight dip to his nose in profile, chin requires depth, bite good. His ears were a good medium size & set wide apart. His eyes are almost round in shape, the blue is a slightly duller tone. Muscular body, well proportioned legs & paws, his tail was marginally short & needed to be fuller. Coat not at its best, it was short & required a greater degree of density, it also required more grooming to the underparts to make the most of what he had, the tail was somewhat sparse, I would have liked it a little silkier. His body is darker & shadier than I would have wished, but there is still contrast to the darker blue points, but he has what in my opinion was a white locket on his throat, also I was not entirely convinced that the area between his legs was not showing some white also but could not be sure in that area. He has almost even socks, but his gauntlets are a little lower than I would have preferred. He was a gentle amiable lad & his condition was sound.

Birman Grand Premier, Male;

GR PR Not Awarded. 1st KIERANS'S PR CARRICKFERN INSIGNIA. SBI c. 22-05-09. Lilac Point, this lad was let down by his colour. Head has quite good width across the cheeks, well developed muzzle, I would prefer a little more rounding to his skull, slight dip in profile, chin adequate, bite very untidy. His ears are set well apart, medium in size. The eye colour has a good depth of blue they are a pleasing almost round shape. The body has good proportions, strong well boned medium length, his tail was reasonably bushy & a balanced medium length. Coat was mid length, with some ruff present, some curl to his tummy, but still very much a summer length & density overall. The body colour was a light magnolia tone with slight hint of tonal shading, his points were very dark & sludgy in tone & lacked the more usual warm pinkish hue, with a very sandy coloured tail. His gloves were low as were the socks but otherwise well matched, unfortunately his gauntlets were not very symmetrical at all & virtually absent on the right, the left more typically tapered to below hock. Very composed chap, who was in very good condition.

Hibernian Burmese Grand Premier;

HIB GR PR SLUITERS'S TARA GR CH & TARA GR PR ALDEBIZ GINCHIKARA. BUR c. 31-03-05. Lilac, very attractive, mature girl (can't really say Lady because she wasn't). Head has very typical Burmese type, with her short wide, blunt wedge, well rounded top line & excellent break, her chin good, bite just acceptable. Ears are medium in size, well placed, rounded tips & hint of tilt. Her eyes I would in an ideally prefer a little larger but that sais hey are a well defined shape with deeply curved lower line & slanted top, light chartreuse colour, withering expression of pure contempt. She has excellent substance for her age, deceptively heavy, well shaped limbs, neat paws, her tail was medium thickness, a little shorter than ideal. Her coat was marginally longer & the slightly plusher texture that develops with age but for a mature madam of her age, perfectly acceptable, the actual texture very good. Hr colour has a pleasing soft warm Dove grey colour & was even in tone. Her condition was wonderful, has a tendency to be a bit of a Diva (well actually quite a lot), she was ultimately Best Burmese, but was not very kind to the members of the panel during the judging for Best Exhibit which meant that was as far as she was going to go.

RES HIB GR PR NOONAN'S TARA GR PR POPPYLOVE MARBLED ORCHID. BUR g. 07-09-10. Blue Tortie, much more genteel lady with wonderful body looking much more substantial than first impressions indicated. Not as typy as the winner but overall pleasing, she has a reasonably short wedge with good width, her muzzle could be a little blunter ideally, good rounding to her top line, shape I would have preferred a little more defined particularly the lower line, a little more leaning to the greener range of chartreuse than ideal, pleasing expression. Body was surprising heavy & well toned, with well proportioned limbs, oval paws, well balanced tail with paintbrush tip. Her coat was sleek & very close lying, could be a little shorter in an ideal world, satin like finish. Her colour was a very good combination of soft blue with varying shades of cream present, soft lustrous sheen to it. Her condition & temperament both superb.

Original Foreign Grand Champion, Male;

GR CH STANISZ'S CH FERNANDEZ SZAFIREX*PL. RUS a. 11-07-04. Russian Blue, very substantial mature lad of 10 years plus who if he were to relax a little could look much improved. I would have preferred his wedge a little shorter, good prominence to his whisker pads, to create breadth, profile has a slight curve to give just enough evidence of angle, his chin could be a little deeper & his bite a little untidy & scissored over. The ears are quite large & have slightly pointed effect to their tips & have sparsely furnished interiors, slightly wider than ideal but he is a very mature lad & has a broad skull. He was incredibly shy & as result has a very worried expression & tends to wide his eyes as a result, giving them a fuller appearance, the green could be a little more intense. He is a very muscular & strong lad who is beautifully grown & excellent length & mature development, long strong legs, oval paws, his tail was a well balanced length. Coat has double qualities, would benefit with a little extra grooming, showing undercoat & slightly longer top coat which I would have preferred softer having a little more resilience ideally. He was such a very gentle chap & his physical condition was excellent.

Original Foreign Grand Champion, Female;

GR CH STANISZ'S CH BELLA SZAFIREX*PL RUS a. 17-05-10. Russian Blue, slightly panicky out of the security of her pen. She has an excellent short wedge from the eyes down, ideally her muzzle could show a little more prominence, profile needs a little more evidence of angle, chin tapers back, bite good. I would prefer her ears a little larger, pointed effect to the tips, set tall when relaxed in her pen. Very good green to her eyes, but these are inclined to being more rounded than almond shape, with a slightly startled expression as a result. Body is well proportioned, slender limbs, broader base to her slightly tapered tail. Very good soft fine top coat, I would in an ideal world like a plusher undercoat. Her colour was a soft shade of blue created by the abundant translucent tipping which created a soft silvery sheen. Very gentle nature & her condition was excellent.

Hibernian Foreign Grand Premier Neuter, Female;

HIB GR PR FIZELLE'S GR PR ACCLAIM DIVA FEVER. MAU ns 24. 04-09-10. Black Silver Spotted Egyptian Mau, slightly rounded wedge, with the gently rounded muzzle flowing into the lines of her cheeks, uniform, width to her nose, profile has a gentle contour ideally requiring a little more evidence of slight rise at the brow line, her chin tapers a little, but the bite good. Ears are medium size, set back slightly on her head & slightly cupped forward. Her eyes are set straight beneath the level brow, with slightly curved lower line with gentle upward slant, good green colour & slightly worried expression in repose. Body has firm tone, if perhaps a little heavier in the mid line, legs are elegant, with tip-toe stance on her oval paws, medium length tail with thicker base. Medium length coat with lovely lustrous sheen, excellent density & slight degree of resilience. Well marked facial tracings including complicated scarab on her brow, her spotting was generally well defined, broken spine line, excellent leg barring, very good tail rings. Her marking almost black on a slightly darker silver ground colour, with slight amount of tarnish present. Her condition & temperament both excellent.

RES HIB GR PR Not Awarded. DIXON'S GR PR AORBOTH MIRABEAU-DIAMOND. ASH ns 11 33.

21-01-11. BCR Brown Silver Shaded Asian, very attractive pattern wise. Her head is a little more rounded in shape as opposed to the required short, wide blunted wedge appearance, with rather fine muzzle, round top but her break is very shallow, her chin tapers, bite good. Ears medium size, require a little more width & slightly more rounding on the tips. The eyes though large & enhanced by the black rims but require more definition to the shape, excellent green colour. Body is medium length & was well proportioned, with good legs & paws, balanced tail. Her coat was not as short as I would wish & it was slightly soft & wispy as opposed to short & sleek. She has an excellent clear silver undercoat with a mantle light shading on the hair tips in black, a little deeper on the brow & tail. Mottles on her ears, brick nose leather & black paws pads. Her condition was excellent, handled well.

Seal Point Birman Adult, Female;

1st CC & BOB. MAXWELL'S TULLYPAWS ROXY. 28-03-13. An attractive lady who will look better with more complete points. She is much more solid & substantial out the pen than first impressions indicated, being excellent overall weight & substance in the body, strong legs, short paws, bushy tail of almost balanced medium length. Sweet face, excellent breadth across her cheeks, well developed muzzle, her skull is well rounded, slight dip in profile her chin tapers slightly to the muzzle, her bite good. The ears are medium in size, set well apart. Almost round shape to her eyes with a very good deep blue eye colour. Her coat was a good length & well prepared, good density, showing pleasing ruff to frame her face. Body colour is beige & deepens on her lower back, some brindling on her mask & tail. Clean white feet markings, slightly uneven gloves & socks but nothing excessive, tapered gauntlets to just below the hocks. Her condition was excellent, super temperament, a very dignified girl.

Blue Point Blue Point Adult, Male;

1st CC & BOB MAXWELL'S TULLPAWS PARIS. 30-04-11. Beautifully grown & very masculine fellow. Head has excellent breadth across the cheeks, well developed muzzle, he has broad rounded skull, showing a slight dip to his profile, with a bump on his nose, good chin & bite. The ears are set well apart & are a good medium size. He has near round eye shape, the colour ideally I would prefer a little more depth of blue. Strong neck, his body was strong & muscular with excellent depth of chest, medium length strong legs, short paws, bushy tail of medium length. The coat was generally a good length, well groomed, good ruff. His coat was a cooler more glacial tone, but with some tonal shading over the shoulders & a little on the flanks, contrast to his points was good, his feet markings were in the main good, well matched gloves, even socks, tapered gauntlets to a little below the hocks were well tapered. He was in excellent condition & has an amicable temperament.

Also Considered for BOB. TANNER-MASON'S CH CARRICKFERN JIGOLO.

Lilac Point Birman Adult, Female;

CC & BOB Not Awarded. 1st TANNER-MASON'S FELONIE KAMASAKI STARLITE. 16-05-10. Very pretty girl who looked essentially feminine but sadly very small & extremely immature looking, all of which was exacerbated by being out of coat. Her head has a very kittenish look about it, requiring more width across her cheeks, the muzzle is good, round skull, slight dip in profile, her chin good, bite untidy. Her ears are medium in size, I would prefer a little more width between. Gorgeous eye colour of deep vivid blue, almost round shape, gentle expression. Body was small & somewhat petite, somewhat fine boned in the limbs & paws, more in keeping with a with a 7-8 month old as opposed to her almost 4 ½ years, her tail was a balanced length but could be bushier. Her coat length could be longer & I would prefer it a little denser, sparse ruff, excellent condition & soft texture, well prepared. Body is a clear near white magnolia colour, delicate warm pinky toned lilac points. Clean white feet, from what could be seen her gloves & socks both even, with tapered

gauntlets on the back legs. Her condition in spite of her more diminutive size was excellent, such a sweet nature, just fails on size & lack of maturity.

Seal Point Birman, Kitten;

1st & BOB TANNER-MASON'S MENTOBE LITTLE-MISCHIEVOUS. 12-03-14. A very showy young lady of excellent type, she really did look quite lovely. Gorgeous face, having excellent width across her well cheeks, excellent muzzle, profile has slight dip to her nose, the chin & bite both good. Beautifully set ears, which are medium size. Lovely eyes of near round shape, the colour has not fully deepened off to the outer rim but are otherwise an excellent depth of blue with pleasing gentle expression. Beautifully grown & excellent weight, with strong limbs, short paws, bushy balanced medium tail. The coat was a very good length & was beautifully prepared, silken texture, already showing her ruff developing, slight curl to the tummy. The contrast betwixt her dense seal points (with the exception of her tail which has still to colour up fully was superb, the coat being perfectly clear. Her gloves are even & end at the angle of the paw/leg, her right sock slightly lower & the right gauntlet was just a tad ragged but otherwise both tapered & end a little below the hocks & were clean & bright. Her condition was superb & she has the sweetest disposition, she was later Best SLH Kitten & would have been my choice for the Overall, my Best Exhibit on the day.

Blue Point Birman Neuter;

Considered for & Awarded BOB. FRIZELLE'S TARA GR PR BAKISTA AUGUSTA ALLANAH. 11-08-10. Very pleasing girl for both type & substance. She has a broad head, with wide cheeks, good muzzle, the skull is well rounded, showing slight dip, her chin requires a little more depth, her bite a little splayed & scissoring over as a result. Ears are set well apart & a pleasing medium size. The eye colour has a pleasing depth of blue to their near rounded shape. Her body is strong & well grown, with good legs & paws, bushy balanced medium length tail. The coat length & density are both good, possessing good degree of ruff, the lower sides & tummy requires a little more grooming. Body has glacial tone & the contrast to her darker blue points is good. Gloves & socks are well matched, as her gauntlets if a little short & could be more tapered. Her condition & temperament both excellent.

Lilac Point Birman Neuter:

Considered for BOB, Not Awarded. KIERANS'S PR CARRICKFERN INSIGNIA.

Russian Blue Adult;

Considered for & Awarded BOB. STANISZ'S CH FERNANDEZ SZAFIREX*PL. Also Considered for BOB. STANISZ'S CH BELLA SZAFIREX*PL RUS a.

Brown Spotted Bengal Adult, Female; Very Close these 2 girls & both well worthy of the CC.

1st CC & BOB DMYTRIYEVA'S DOBSHANGRILA GOLDIE. 26-07-13. Though I actually preferred the head type of the other girl this girl had by far the better coat qualities. Her head ideally could show a little more rounded appearance, good cheeks, muzzle requires a little more prominence, I would prefer her brow to show a little more rounding, slight break, her chin was good, level bite, widely set canines. Her ears marginally larger & wider at their base, than I would have preferred. Her eyes are a large rounded oval shape, green colour. Body was well grown & muscular, excellent length, strong legs, round paws, quite a thick tail which was a good medium length. Wonderful coat quality, the beautifully luxurious & tipped the balance, it was dense shorter medium length, beautifully soft. Her markings were beautifully dramatic. Well defined facials, spotted whisker pads, striking cheek ribbons, which continue under the chin to form a chin strap, lines over her neck, scrolls on the shoulders, broken spine line, multiple rosettes on her sides of various size, all of which are quite striking & beautifully contrasted, excellent leg barring & tail bands. Her body spotting shows triple colour & are sharply defined against the rich ruddy golden ground colour, well marked heels,

spotted tummy. Her condition was splendid & she has such a gentle nature & was beautifully composed.

2nd DMYTRIYEVA'S DOBSHANGRILA XENA. 30-09-11. Another girl who was a very nice example of her breed, The better head type having a more typical slightly rounded wedge, high cheeks, good prominence to her whisker pads, slightly rounded brow, firm chin, bite level (not keen on having t checked. Her ears are smaller medium size, set well. Very good green to her eye colour, these are large & a full round oval shape. Body is perhaps a little more rounded in her mid line than ideal (sounds like my own problem), good length overall, strong legs, round paws, balanced moderately thick tail. Her coat was short & dense, medium length not so obviously soft as the girl above. Excellent facial markings, with all the required elements, cheek stripes, complicated scarab & 'M', spotted whisker pads, lines down her neck, broken spine line, her pattern whilst not quite so dramatic as the winner it was nevertheless equally striking in its own right, with well defined contrast to the dense black elements, including a tear drop shaped heart spot on one side, spotted tummy, broad leg barring, spots onto her toes, linked tail bands with the odd spot. Her ground colour was a rich with brighter apricot undercoat & sharp clear contrast as a result. Lovely condition & again her temperament like her stable companion was amicable & good natured.

AC Sphyx Adult, Female;

CC & BOB Not Awarded. 1st SIRVAITIENE'S APELA JOLEMUR*LT. SPH d 03. 11-02-12. Red Bi-Colour, rather tetchy girl who is somewhat narrow in the head. She has a longer wedge shaped head requiring more cheeks definition, fine muzzle, which lacks the required whisker pad prominence, her profile is almost straight requires a little more evidence of break, her chin requires a little more depth & width, bite good. Her ears are large, wide base, some ear muffs & a little more covering than ideal, she does tend to prick them requiring a little more angulation. The eyes are rather acute in shape, lacking the full lemon as per SOP's, eau de nil colour. Body is firm & well muscled, elegant appearance, legs are in proportion, long finer like paws, fine tail. Her body has pleasing lack of coat, with the more typical chamois effect, it does extend more up the nose, than I would prefer & the tail is fuzzier & hairier towards its tip. Her condition was very good, but somewhat uptight in temperament.

Russian Blue Kitten;

BOB Not Awarded. 1st **SCARLETT'S ABIGAIL ARMANI.** 24-03-13. This kitten was very small for his age & his development was not indicative of his age. He has a reasonably short wedge but he lacks the prominence to the whisker pads to give the required Russian appearance, I would like a little more evidence of angle in profile, chin okay, his bite was good, but interesting in that he appeared to be teething & I queried his age as a result. His ears set was excellent, tall & pricked, pointed tips, light interior furnishings. Body is small & is a little lighter in weight than his age indicated, slender limbs, neat paws, balanced tail length. His coat was rather wispy & almost fluffy as opposed to double. Overall his colour was a rather speckled effect, with plenty of silvery sheen but not very even. He was a very confident youngster, condition was good, but he has a great deal of catching up to do growth wise in relation to his age.

AC Sphynx Kitten;

1st & BOB. HENSON'S SPHYNXALIENS ROCKY ROAD. SPH n 21. 06-06-14. Brown Tabby, what a lovely little chap. Head is excellent, its length a little longer than wide, well defined cheeks, with some whisker break, slightly puffed whisker pads, he has a flat brow, slight break in profile, chin I would like stronger, his bite level. The ears, are large, wide base, well angled setting. His eyes are again large, correct full lemon shape & gentle slant, colour still to settle, quizzical expression. Beautifully firm body, excellent weight, medium length, well proportioned length of limb, well cushioned paw pads to his paws, with long finger like toes, long fine tail. He has only the very finest of covering on his ears, with slight amount of hair on the bridge of his nose, fine fuzz on his tail

otherwise free of excess hair to his the very fine chamois effect on his body & legs. His condition was splendid & he has a wonderfully confident temperament & was later Best of Variety Foreign Exhibit, congratulations.

Brown Spotted Bengal Neuter;

1st PC & BOB. DMYTRIYEVA'S DOBSHANGRILA BRAMS. 22-02-12. Noisy lad who was demanding attention. His head is a little longer & requires a little more rounding to his wedge, some muzzle pinch & his whisker pads require more prominence, profile has very slight break at the eye line, chin & bite good. He has larger ears than I would prefer which are also a little too wide at the base & as a result a little too flared. The eyes are quite large rounded oval shape, green colour. Body has good length with firm well muscled appearance, well proportioned limbs, round paws, tail I would prefer a little thicker. His coat was dense medium length, though not as ultra luxurious as I would wish. Excellent facial tracings with dramatic cheek ribbons, linking in to a chin strap, complicated 'M' & scarab, spotted whisker pads, body pattern is very unusual it was beautifully contrasted with long very dense elongated & linked spots, excellent leg barring & tail rings. As stated excellent contrast but the ground colour was rather dull & lacked the usual bright russet colour. His condition & temperament both excellent, very vocal, his certificate was very borderline based on the comments detailed above.

AC Sphynx Neuter;

PC & BOB Not Awarded. 1st WELDON'S NOBILERO MORRIGAWN RUA. SPH d 03 21. 28-11-13. Somewhat hairy which precluded the award of a certificate. Her head is a little longer than wide & she has quite pleasing prominence to his whisker pads, some whisker break, well defined cheeks, her profile too straight, chin was good, bite level. Her ears are large & have good wide base, could be a little more angular & she is a little inclined to tilt forward a little. Eyes are very acutely angled & are more oriental than slanted full lemon shape, excellent green colour albeit no points. Body is firm & well muscled, good length, well proportioned on her legs, well cushioned paw pads, fine tail. She has quite an amount of hair covering her ears & this extends up the bridge of the nose from the muzzle, with some hair also up her legs & very hairy on her tail particularly towards the tip where it was completely covered, she also has some lighter amounts on her body. Wonderful condition, grumbly but not difficult.

Burmilla or Asian Smoke Neuter;

Considered for BOB, Not Awarded. DIXON'S GR PR AORBOTH MIRABEAU-DIAMOND. ns 11 33.

Cream Burmese Adult, Male;

Disqualified SLUITERS'S BACKCHAT KAPELLMEISTER. 22-11-13. Young lad with a rather major problem fro an entire male in that he is actually not fully entire in all departments. His head has a reasonably short wedge with good width, but it could be blunter in the muzzle & requires more width at the jaw hinge, reasonable rounded top but rather shallow break, fair chin, bite good. His ears are medium in size, rounded tips, just to widen a little more. His eyes I would prefer larger & they are a little more slanted on the lower line & require more depth of curve, colour requires more evidence of yellow tone to give a more typical chartreuse, rather gentle expression. His body was well muscled albeit typically adolescent as yet, unfortunately he was lacking in full equipment for an entire male being monorchid, the one he has was well developed but sadly does not make up for not having 2, well shaped legs & paws, with balanced medium length tail & blunt tip. His coat was close lying & sleek, could be a little shorter but well prepared & has a lovely satin like finish. Colour is a slightly warmer cream tone, showing some barring on the limbs & quite a heavy albeit broken necklet. He was an incredibly sweet nature youngster whose hormones had obviously not fully kicked in, excellent condition.

Cream Burmese Adult, Female;

1st CC & BOB. TAYLOR'S BACKCHAT SUN CHARIOT. (CH) 03-05-12. Gentle natured girl. Her head could ideally be a little shorter & wider, with a little broader muzzle, top rounds, I would like more evidence of break, her chin & bite good. Well set medium size ears, slight hint of forward tilt & rounded tips. Her eyes were reasonably large, just requiring the benefit of more curvature on the lower line, light chartreuse colour. Her body was firm & weighty, excellent medium length, well proportioned limbs, oval paws, balanced medium length & thickness to her tail. Coat was a good shorter length & has a sleek close lying texture & good density also. Her colour is a warm shade of cream deepening on her back & tail, she has slight smudges & was showing a slight well broken necklet, her condition & temperament both excellent.

Lilac Burmese Neuter;

Considered for & Awarded BOB. SLUITERS'S TARA GR CH & TARA GR PR ALDEBIZ GINCHIKARA.

AOC Tortie Burmese Neuter;

Considered for & Awarded BOB. NOONAN'S TARA GR PR POPPYLOVE MARBLED ORCHID.

Red Burmese Neuter;

PC & BOB Not Awarded. 1st TAYLOR'S BACKCHAT ROSENKAVLIER. 22-11-13. If temperament were all he would have obtained a certificate, as he was such a very amicable good natured youngster with a very gentle meow. His head is at present more medium length than short & requires a little more width at, his muzzle is not as blunt as I would wish, slightly flat on his brow line which was exacerbated due to only having a gentle break in profile, small nose rise, his chin & bite both okay. Medium size, ears, rounded tips, still to widen off a little more. His eyes I would prefer larger& the shape more defined, the colour typically chartreuse. Body is as yet typically adolescent as is his right by virtue of age, but generally good musculature development for that age, with proportionate legs & paws, medium length tail with paintbrush tip. His coat was close lying & well prepared, good shorter length. His colour has yet to intensify into a more vibrant tangerine with slight paling towards the lower sides, quite a heavy necklet which will become much less apparent if his colour deepens. He was in excellent condition & was a very vocal friendly young chap.

Non-Pedigree Section;

AOC Cat;

1st & BOB O'GAILLIGAN'S ROCKY. Brown & White. 5 ½ Years, I did like this mature girl who looked clean & the white contrasted beautifully against her Tonkinese colouration of darker points with dark seal shading on the body, it was short & well prepared with a lovely close lying appearance. Her ears were clean, the eyes beautifully clean & bright, combined with a most attractive blue washed green colour. Body beautifully firm. Her condition was splendid, neds to relax a little as she was a might uptight.

AC Kitten, Male;

1st HAYDE'S YODA. Black & White. 4 Months, this lad looked like a typical alley cat with his black eye & blue check neckerchief. Head is longer than wide, his cheeks need to be higher & more defined, good muzzle, profile has a concave at the nasal bridge, with slight rise on the nose, fair chin, bite good. His ears were quite large & he pricks these tall, tufted tips, the interior furnishing could be longer. His eyes were smaller & deeper in set than I would prefer & lose out on the rounded shape, green colour, worried expression. Well grown lad with long rectangular shaped body which could carry a little more weight, strong legs, large tufted paws, tail long but requires more plume & fullness. Sadly his coat lacked length & was greasy, lacking in the required preparation for show purposes, it was very unkempt with knots & tangles on the underparts, needs more ruff & breeches. His pattern elements are actually or more accurately could look good if prepared correctly, his silver ground colour was looking dull & he was heavily tarnished with lots of brownish overlay on his face, legs, body & tail. He was a gentle if rather frightened lad but his poor presentation let him down badly.

Ears were moderately large, these need to be lower & wider at their base. Good neckline, beautifully firm well proportioned body, with good fine legs, oval paws, her tail could ideally be a little longer. Her cat is a little longer than I would prefer & has a slightly plusher woollier texture as opposed to sleek & satin like. Clear light ivory colour with excellent contrast to her points which were showing some degree of brindling with paler muzzle & some spectacles, the points colour a very dark bitter chocolate colour lacks the required warmth & more milk chocolate tone. Her condition appeared excellent, her temperament not exactly conducive to allow suitable handing to be able to justify a certificate.
