AC PERSIAN/EXOTIC GRAND CHAMPION

HIBERNIAN TO WALLS TARA HIB.GR. CH. SHEERBLISS ENRICO – 70 31a (14.4.07)

Big Mature Blue/White Bi-Colour, solid and chunky, strong thick legs rounded paws, breadth to chest and head. Rounded top of head, well set small ears, big round eyes, nose short and broad, fat cheeks and firm chin. His coat was thick and stood away well, dense mid blue patches, pristine white to face legs and tummy, all balanced off with a short thick blue tail, a real masculine boy with a laid back nature.

AC EXOTIC PREMIER

GR. PR. LEES PR SHEERBLISS GIFT WRAPPED – 70 30s (1.11.08) Another grand mature Boy, Black Silver Spotted, built like a tank, strong heavy bone, solid body and round head. Ears small and feathered, super big wide open expressive eyes, short nose with strong break, fat cheeks, good chin. Thick short legs and big paws, tail thick and showing tabby rings. Coat moulting but still retains a thick texture, lots of spotting to body on a silver ground, classic markings to head – gentle lad a pleasure to handle.

RES. BYRNES PR. SHEERBLISS RAVEN – 70 6 (2.5.13) Black Smoke youngster, not yet got the maturity of the winner but well developed for his age, round apple head, small ears, eyes a deep orange, nicely rounded, short wide nose, good break, firm chin. Limbs sturdy, body solid, tail is thick with a rounded end. Glossy black coat with silvery contrasts showing on body and head, good texture for time of year although he was moulting – such a friendly boy.

AV SEMI-LH GRAND CHAMPION

HIBERNIAN TO KUSMIERZ GR. & SUPREME CH. BULGARI BUBU-COONS – 64.41

(8.5.11) Big gentle Brown Tabby Maine Coon lad. Long lean body, his limbs thick, high and strong, really large paws with under tufts, strong head, his ears wide based and held very high, long tips, lovely oblique set greenish eyes, firm chin and a square muzzle. Coat thick but soft showing classic markings to back and sides, M to head, spectacles round eyes, eye lines, rings to legs and showing on his very long full tail – a quality boy who later became overall BIS many congratulations.

AV SEMI-LH GRAND PREMIER – MALE

HIBERNIAN TO NOONANS TARA GR. PR. POPPYLOVE GASPY MENELIK 66w (16.5.10) very well shown Seal Mitted Ragdoll lad who had strong limbs and rounded paws, muscular long body. Flat plane to strong head, wide based ears set tilted slightly forward, his nose with a gentle curve, firmness to chin, big mid blue eyes set slightly oblique. Dark seal to ears and full mask, seal to limbs, pristine white to paws, back legs white to hock, chin chest and tummy white, body shaded beige to back paler to sides – a very handsome gentleman.

FEMALE

HIBERNIAN TO FRIZELLES TARA GR.PR BAKISTA AUGUSTA ALLANAH 13c2

(11/8/10) Gentle Blue Birman lady with a nice balanced head, her ears medium and set well apart, slight dip to medium nose, bright even blue eyes, set slightly obliquely, width to cheeks. Body a

balanced length, strong limbs and rounded paws. Soft well groomed coat, the body clear and pale, bluish grey to ears, mask, slightly paler on limbs and balanced bushy tail. White even gloves covering paws, socks covering back legs, gauntlets about half way to the hock and tapered – a very sleepy girl who was lovely to handle.

AOV SEMI-LH PREMIER

GR. PR. FORBES PR. SHARALO ALASTAIR – 66w (24.8.12) A very gentle Seal Mitted Ragdoll boy who was great to handle, very soft thick well prepared coat. Strong high limbs, large paws, length to body. Mature head with wide based ears set well apart, gentle curve to nose, firm chin, big deep blue eyes, just a tad off centre. Body coat beige with shading to back, dark seal to ears and mask, paler to limbs and full tail, neat white mitts.

RED/TORTIE/CREAM/BLUE- CREAM, CHOCOLATE ETC. SMOKE ADULT

1ST. CC & BOB WALKERS SHEERBLISS GIPSY ROSE – 70 6ev (1.7.13) Most attractive Tortie Smoke lady wearing a full well groomed coat showing shades of red and black, silvery undercoat coming in at roots, very wide full tail. Strong and cobby in build, thick short legs and large rounded paws. Width to top of head, small well set ears with silvery furnishings, broad nose good break, firm chin, large round orange eyes, acceptable bite – well mannered girl.

A.C SILVER CLASSIC/MACKEREL/ SPOTTED TABBY ADULT

1ST. CC & BOB CRAIGS JOLEIGH LILLIE OF SHEERBLISS – 7d (7.9.13) Red Silver Tabby lady, her coat had a super pale silvery red under coat, top coat has some tabby markings, faint on head, rings on legs and slight shoulder markings, would like to see them more developed. Attractive head, good width, neat ears, large deep copper eyes, so nice to see this deep colour, short nose with ample break, firm chin, her cheeks full and rounded. Short wide tail showing good contrasts, again very slight tabby rings. Good bone and substance – super preparation, finished off with a lovely temperament.

CHINCHILLA & SHADED SILVER – MALE

1ST. CC & BOB GUINEY ZILVA OSCAR WILD – 10 (2.7.13) Well made boy with good bone and substance, cobby body, thick legs and big feathered feet. Masculine head but still retains the “chinnny” look, neat small ears, round well outlined eyes of a aqua green, his nose broad with nice stop, brick black outlined leather, firm chin. Full coat, soft and nicely presented, the new coat coming in at roots, his back tipping is rather heavy at present, he looks boarder line shaded silver, but this should change when he gets his full winter plumage, nice full short tail – grand lad to handle.

FEMALE

1ST. & CC GUINEY OWLETTS MARGOT FONTEYN - 10 (22.5.12) A very pretty lass her coat lightly tipped in black with a sparkling almost white undercoat. Small but compact, short legs and round paws with lots of furnishings, short bushy tail to balance. Rounded head, neat ears, short nose, fair break, pink leather, firm chin, lovely big expressive nicely outlined eyes – most attractive young lady.

BI-COLOUR – ADULT

1ST. CC & BOB MOLLOY'S CELOSIA ARTHUR – 12a7 (1.8.12) Cream/White boy, big boned and good substance, slightly rangy in body, but thick strong limbs and big feet. Masculine head with well furnished neat ears, round deep orange eyes, nose broad with a strong break, full cheeks. Nicely groomed coat sound cream to face, back and a short full cream tail. The white areas pristine – laid back lad.

TABBY COLORPOINT ADULT –MALE

1ST. CC & BOB MALCOLMSONS JENZJEWELS MERLINS GOLD – 13b15 (31.3.13) Red Tabby Point lad wearing a very full soft clear coat, nicely presented. Solid in build with strong legs and paws. Broad head, ears small and nicely furnished, short wide nose with good break, his cheeks full, firm chin, lots of whichway white whiskers big expressive eyes of a very good blue. Warm red to ears and mask, an M just showing, slight tabby markings on legs and his short very full mid red tail has some under rings.

FEMALE

1ST. & CC MALCOLMSONS RISSETTA SUGARPUFF – 13b16 (23.7.13) Well marked Seal Tortie Tabby. Pretty lass small but compact, thick short legs, rounded paws. Good width to top of head, neat ears, big round mid blue eyes, nose broad with nice break, firm chin. Coat showing tabby markings and tortie colours to head and legs, tortie shading to back, short wide tail ringed and two tone – very shy little girl.

DILUTE TIPPED OR SHADED CAMEO

1st. CC & BOB CRAIGS SUNLIT GEORGIE – Cream Tipped boy with a super coat, lightly tipped in soft pale cream, almost white undercoat, full and very well groomed. Solid body and short strong legs, big feathered paws. Broad head with good width between his small ears, broad nose with good stop, fat cheeks and a firm chin, large round orange eyes. His tail very wide and full with light even cream tipping -a quality lad pleasure to handle.

BLUE OR LILAC TORTIE & WHITE – KITTEN

1ST & BOB MOLLOY'S CATSCASTLE BARCELONA – 12 2 (13.3.14) Very pretty Tortie & White baby, solid and stocky in build, short thick little legs, big paws. Rounded top of head, big eyes the colour a promising muddy brown, short little nose with good break, cheeks filling out, nice firm chin. Well Groomed coat showing patches of red and black, pristine white on body, tummy and head, short little red and black tail - a very promising young girl.

BI-COLOUR NEUTER

1ST. PC & BOB HARTES KARALO GEOFFREY SANTA CRUZ – 12a5 (25.4.12) Solid big boned Red/White lad, thick legs, large paws. Wide head with well set ears, his nose broad, medium length with slight break, firm chin, lovely large round copper eyes, overall an open expression. Thick coat with rich red patches, clear white areas but he needed a bit more preparation to bring out his best – nice temperament.

AC TABBY OR TABBY & WHITE EXOTIC NEUTER

BOB LEES SHEERBLISS GIFTWRAPPED

1ST. & PC WALLS SHEERBLISS NIKOLAI – 70 30s (28.9.06) Big masculine boy with a strong round head, large eyes the colour faded a little with age, short broad nose with strong break, fat cheeks and firm chin, acceptable bite. Strong bone and substance, well padded tummy, thick legs and large paws. Nice textured coat showing black spotting on a silver ground, tabby M Spectacles and eye lines to head, rings on legs, thick ringed tail – a big gentle lad.

AC SIBERIAN ADULT

1ST. CC & BOB KUSMIERZ SOTORP BRUTUS – 82 38s (22.10.08) Mature boy, solid with lots of “heft” to his body, strong thick legs and large paws. Masculine head with nicely positioned

ears, round slightly oblique set to his eyes, width to cheeks, muzzle could be a touch stronger. Thick coat with a soft undercoat, well presented, tabby to head and legs, tail in balance to body, full and slightly ringed – easy going fellow.

AC COLOURPOINTED OR MITTED RAGDOLL KITTEN

1ST. & BOB JUNS SHARALO ZEINA HAGE – 66 (24.3.14) Seal Colourpointed baby, a most attractive youngster, good development for his age, good bone and substance, rounded paws and strong legs. His head broadening with a flat plane between his ears, which are set well apart and have a slight forward tilt, large eyes again set nicely apart, a sound blue, medium nose with slight dip, muzzle still a little pinched. Baby soft coat of a light beige, dark seal to ears and over nose, spreading to his cheeks, slightly paler seal to legs and short tail – lovely nature a promising kitten.

AC BI-COLOUR RAGDOLL NEUTER

1ST. PC & BOB HARTES COLLINS GARDEN XANTE – 66 31 (29.7.13) Very shy lad, well shown full coat nice texture. Strong head, flat plane between ears set slightly tilted, lovely big strong blue eyes, medium nose with a slight dip, still a little narrow in muzzle. Strong bone and substance, thick legs and big paws, length to body. Coat beige shading lighter to sides, dark seal to ears and legs, tail well furnished a mid seal. White almost even inverted triangle to face, white to chest, legs and tummy.

TABBY OR TABBY & WHITE - MALE

1ST. & BOB RUNDAS KNOT – Big gentle Tabby & White boy wearing a well groomed Semi-LH coat, thick but soft. Big and strong in bone, well padded. Big bright wide open hazel eyes, high ears, alert expression, Long well furnished tail to balance – a lovely lad nice to handle.

2nd. HUGHES SIMBA – Mature Brown Tabby Shorthair boy of over 15 years, still looking very good, his coat showing nice tabby markings, thick texture. Strong limbs and big paws, Thick tail with lots of tabby rings. Lovely big eyes a greenish hazel, alert expression. – touch edgy but at his age he is entitled!

3RD. FLOODS BOBBY Big well padded Blue Tabby & White lad, fat tummy, strong legs and feet. Coat well marked, the white areas sparkling, the texture thick but soft, well shown laid back boy.

FEMALE

1ST. FLOODS SWEETIE – Brown Tabby lass, mature and well developed, she had a lovely tabby coat, looked like a little tiger. High ears and super big wide open greenish eyes. Strong bone and good substance, thick legs and rounded paws, she was rather shy but liked a cuddle, she lived up to her name.

GINGER OR GINGER & WHITE CAT.

1ST. & BOB O’GALLIGANS TIGGY – Tabby & White, lovely friendly lad, very well made with good bone. Thick but soft coat with rich red tabby markings, bright white on his face and chest, his tail has lots of rings and a bend partway down, all adding to his charm. Big bright wide open eyes, strong head, lots of whiskers – grand boy lovely to handle.

TORTIE OR TORTIE & WHITE CAT

1ST. & BOB TERRYS MATTIE – A pretty Tortie & White lady, a little grumpy but handled fine. Attractive coat showing bright tortie colours, white triangle on her face, paws white. Very well padded in body, high ears and bright alert eyes – nicely shown.

2nd. Just by a whisker WALSHS ABI – Very pretty Tortie & White, coat semi-long hair showing rich red and dense black. Nice bright greenish eyes, high ears well feathered, strong limbs and very long red/black tail – ran winner close.
