HIBERNIAN CLASS FOR AV SEMI-LONG HAIR GRAND PREMIER MALE

HIB. CALLEN & RUSSELLS SUP.TARA GR PR. & INT. GR. PR ISHCUS RED DEVIL – (12.3.06) Massive Red Tabby Maine Coon in lovely show condition, glossy thick coat showing dark red classic tabby markings to head and body on a soft red ground. Long well padded body, thick high limbs and large paws, balanced off with a long tail reaching his shoulders. Broad skull, wide based ears, long tips and nicely furnished, his nose broad with a concave curve, excellent strength to square muzzle – lovely laid back temperament on this lad.

RES. KIERANS GR. PR. CARRICKFERN FIRECRACKER – (9.6.06) Red Tabby Point Birman, another who was well developed, solid body and sturdy limbs. Mature head with width to cheeks, well set ears, slight profile dip, ears spaced nicely apart, lovely eyes of a deep blue. Warm red to ears with slight thumb prints, M to forehead, rings to legs and bushy tail, body a warm golden cream, the texture starting to go a little harsh on back. Ruff framing his head, very curly under parts, even tapered gauntlets, neat socks – another boy who was easy to handle.

AC TABBY OR TABBY & WHITE EXOTIC NEUTER - MALE

- 1ST. PC & BOB HENDERSONS SHEERBLISS SAMURAI (17.7.10) Red Tabby & White wearing a well groomed coat of good texture, showing sound red and pristine white, tabby M to forehead, white to chest and tummy, rich red ringed short tail. Round balanced head with small neat ears, broad nose good break, fat cheeks, firm chin, large expressive copper eyes laid back lad.
- 2ND. LEES SHEERBLISS GIFT WRAPPED (<u>IGR.PR</u> & PR) (1.11.08) Big Silver Spotted Tabby, cobby and solid, short thick legs and big rounded paws. Strong masculine head, ears neat, large eyes, when he would open them! would like a deeper colour. Thick well groomed coat standing away from body nicely, showing distinct black markings on a silvery ground, thick ringed tail with a rounded tip friendly lad.

Also considered for BOB MORTONS SHEERBLISS WACKO JACKO – Tabby & White with a well groomed coat.

FEMALE

1ST. & PC. HENDERSONS SHEERBLISS MAGGIEMAY – (25.10.09) Black Silver Tabby, very gentle lass, round apple head with large expressive mid orange eyes, ears just a touch open, nicely feathered, firm chin, short nose. Coat soft but the texture nice, standing away

well, good black markings to head, M, spectacles and eye lines, body nicely marked, tail thick with a rounded end and tabby rings.

AOC NON-SELF EXOTIC NEUTER

1st.PC & BOB LEES SHEERBLISS OH SO THEO (CH.& IGRPR) – (14.4.07)

Solid well made Cream & White Bi-Colour in great show condition, solid chunky build, thick legs and big paws. Mature rounded head with full cheeks, broad nose with strong break, open nostrils and wide leather, big expressive eyes of a rich copper, firm chin. Very nice coat of a thick soft texture, standing away nicely, mid cream to body and head, white on face and round neck, tail thick a solid cream – lovely natured lad.

A.C. COLOURPOINTED OR MITTED RAGDOLL ADULT

BOB NERETTI & GIBBONS GR.CH POLLYLOVE MAORI LEGEND – (24.1.10)

Chocolate Colourpointed, solid with strong limbs and muscular body, rounded paws. Broad head with flat plane to forehead, ears wide based with a forward tilt, big expressive mid blue eyes slightly obliquely set, firm chin, gentle curve to nose.

Soft coat showing milk chocolate to mask and limbs, tail bushy a paler chocolate, very slight shading to body – easy going boy.

AC BI-COLOUR ADULT

1ST PC & BOB RASZKAS PL*GREGORIS CAT ZOSIA – (3.9.11) Blue Bi-Colour lady with a lovely gentle nature. Good size and substance for age, strong limbs, rounded paws. Broad head, ears still a little large for balance, flat plane to forehead, large mid blue eyes, curve to nose and good chin. Soft well groomed coat the body a pale bluish white, slate blue to ears and face, inverted white triangle to face, white chin, chest, tummy and paws, back legs white to body, tail bushy in balance a soft slate blue.

NORWEGIAN FOREST ADULT

1ST. CC & BOB LENIHANS COOMAKISTA DAMON – (17.5.11) Very shy Brown Tabby & White boy, he had an excellent coat for texture, soft woolly undercoat, the top coat coarse and glossy showing nice overall tabby markings, white to paws and tummy. Triangular head shape, straight profile, his ears wide based, settling into contours of head, green oblique eyes just a touch deep set. Ruff from his shoulders, tail long and ringed reaching almost to neck. Long bodied with high limbs – well shown.

AC SIBERIAN KITTEN

1ST. & BOB KUSMIERZ TUNEZJA NOWA ERA (18.6.12) – Delightful Tortie Tabby, already showing good texture to her coat, top coat harsh, soft undercoat developing, good tortie colours to body and head, ruff coming in. Tabby to head, M, spectacles, rings to legs, slight rings on tail which needs to fill out. Small but compact build, strong legs, head a broad wedge, cheeks widening out, firm chin, medium ears wide set, eyes bright, slightly oval, the colour not yet sorted – super lively temperament, my take home baby.

2ND. DIXONS SORBONA NOWA ERA*PL – (7.6.12) Tabby Colour Point youngster, coat still baby soft needing undercoat, a pale magnolia, light seal points, mask developing, tabby

M to head, slight rings to legs and tail. Lovely expressive eyes of a deep baby two tone blue, slight curve to nose, muzzle still rather pinched, ears set wide apart a little high. Nice bone for age – a promising friendly girl who is just staring to go adolescent.

AV BI-COLOUR RAGDOLL NEUTER

1ST. PC & BOB NERETTI & GIBBONS <u>SUP.GR.CH</u> LADYDOLL BOADICEA – (9.8.06) Solid well made Blue Bi-colour girl, good bone and substance. Long body and strong limbs and big paws, mature head, flat plane between well set ears, curve to nose, good chin, slightly oblique set eyes. Lovely coat for texture a bluish white, paler to sides, slate blue to mask, ears and bushy balanced tail. White triangle to face, chin, chest, tummy and legs – easy going girl, nice to handle.

BROWN SPOTTED BENGAL ADULT - MALE

1ST. BOB & PC MATJUGOVAS DOBSHANGRILA WILSON – (11.8.11) Long well balanced lad with strong but elegant limbs. Broad wedge shaped head, gentle curve to profile, broad nose with puffed leather, good chin, large oval eyes a nice hazel colour, well set ears. Very nice dense soft coat, warm rufus ground, excellent distinct markings, scarab, eye lines whisker spots to head, necklaces, rings to legs, spots on tummy and toes, back lines breaking, rosettes and spots to body, tail thick rounded, a dark tip- a very nice lad with a good temperament.

FEMALE

1ST. & CC DMYTRIYEVAS DOBSHANGRILA XENA – (30.8.11) Nice young lass, her head need a touch more maturity, but she has well set ears, curve to profile, oblique set bright eyes. Dense soft coat, pale rufus ground, warmer on tummy, good clear markings. Complex scarab to head carrying over to neck, eyes lines, spotted whisker pads, necklaces, rosettes to sides, rings on legs, her tail quite long, ringed with a dark tip – friendly girl.

SNOW SPOTTED (AOC or Blue eyed) ADULT – MALE

1ST. CC & BOB MacDONALD & QUINN GLITTERGLAM OSCAR OF RAKASTA – (14.7.11) Big muscular Blue-eyed lad in lovely condition, strong sleek body, medium legs strong with large paws. Broad medium wedge shaped head, ears medium, rounded tips and set wide apart, almost round large eyes of a medium blue.

Dense soft coat, ivory ground with a pearly sheen, light brown markings, head showing pale scarab, spectacles round eyes, thumb print on ears, brick black outlined nose leather, tail thick slightly tapered with a brown tip – super temperament on this boy, a pleasure to handle.

 2^{ND} . DYMTRIYEVAS DOBSHANRILA ZEFIR – (13.11.11) Another Blue-eyed boy, again in super show condition. Not quite as mature as the winner, head a nice wedge, muzzle just a little narrow, curve to profile, good chin, ears still a touch large. Lovely sleek soft coat, pale ivory ground with light brown markings. Well marked head with spectacles round eyes, whisker spots, brick leather outlined in black. Muscular body with strong legs and feet, tail long, tapered with a dark tip – lovely natured boy very promising.

BROWN SPOTTED BENGAL NEUTER - FFEMALE

1st.PC & BOB DMYTRIYEVA DOBSHANGRILA EZIRA – (28.8.09) Balanced mature girl wearing a dense soft coat, very well marked, broken back lines, lots of spots to body and tummy, rosettes to sides, ground to body a dark warm rufus, lighter on tummy, rings to legs and long tapered tail. Medium wedge shaped head, ears medium with wide base and rounded at tips, large oval eyes of a warm hazel, brick red leather, scarab to top of head, spectacles round eyes – well shown lady.
