HIBERNIAN GRAND CHAMPION (INVICTUS) MALE; INV CC; Steiner-Browne HIB GR CH FRIENDLYGHOST BIG BEAR almost four years old and a strong well developed lad with excellent bone structure and very large paws with great tufts. Ears are set quite high with a good width apart. Cheeks are fairly full and high set cheek bones. Square muzzle and nice depth to the chin, just a touch more breadth for perfection. Level bite. Well shaped eyes and a green colouring. Soft top coat with the pattern a little solid along the spine. Very good length and texture. Tail with profuse and flowing fur.

HIBERNIAN GRAND CHAMPION (INVICTUS) FEMALE; INV CC; Wagner HIG GR CH & INT GR CH UNICUM TESLA blue tortie classic tabby and white of just over five years old. A strong and well grown female with lovely substance and a rectangular body shape. Her ears are nicely positioned and her cheek bones are set with a good width. Eyes have a slightly oblique aperture and set with a green colouring, I would have liked them a touch larger for perfection. Square muzzle and chin with a nice depth and breadth. Level bite. White to the paws chest and tummy. Soft textured top coat and a good undercoat. Tail nicely covered and balances with the body. Patches of blue and cream with some tabby evident.

HIBERNIAN GRAND PREMIER (INVICTUS) FEMALE; INV PC; Wren CH & SUP TARA HIB GR PR DELPHINIUM SUMMER-MORNING black silver classic tabby approaching six years old. Fairly cobby body and a very good size for a girl. Lovely bone structure and strong bone to the legs with firm rounded paws. Tail in balance with the body and thicker at the base with a rounded tip. Her ears are medium sized and she has a nicely rounded head. Large almost round eyes of a medium green colouring. Medium length nose and very nicely rounded cheeks. Level bite and nice strength to the chin. Super balance to the head. Short coat with a very good density and wonderful texture, she is just moulting a little. Super black markings to form the classic tabby pattern and a good silver ground. The crisp texture on this coat was what swung the result her way. RES INV PC; Wagner SUP TARA IS HIB GR PR & INT GR PR ISHCUS QUEVEGA tortie classic tabby and white Maine Coon female who is nearly seven years old. A super looking female who is in tip top condition and ran the winner extremely close, it was a tough call in this class. She is large with a rectangular body shape. Large ears set quite high and with a good width apart and long tufts to the tips. Her cheek bones are high set and fairly full. Slight concave curve at the nasal bridge. Square muzzle and nice depth and breadth to the chin. Green eye colouring to the eyes which have a slightly oblique aperture and set. Wonderful feel to the coat which has a soft top coat and some undercoat. Very well presented. Classic pattern can be seen. Tail is well covered and in balance with the body.

SECT 4 HIBERNIAN GRAND CHAMPION; HBC; Conchobhair & Wood GR CH & INT CH
CHEREK NUTJEST ANY JINJANUT red Devon Rex who is almost six years old.

Medium sized body. Fairly short broad wedge with high cheek bones. Nice strength to the muzzle and the chin is almost in line with the tip of the nose. Small whisker break and a moderately short nose. Large ears which are low set and wide at the base. Oval shaped eyes showing a green colouring. He does tend to open them fully when he is out of the pen, the shape looks much better when relaxed. Tummy showing a covering of fur. His back has a short coat with some density and a nice wave. Friendly and easy to handle.

SECT 5 HIBERNIAN GRAND PREMIER; HGP w/h 1; Sluiters GR PR SLIABH

GINHIROYUKI lilac Burmese lad of nearly six years old. A well grown chap with his head in proportion to the body, as he is quite big his body is a touch long. He has nice width at the cheek bones and rounded top of head between the ears. Small break to the nose in profile. Chin not quite in line with the end of the nose. Ears are medium to large in size and have a slight tilt forward. Rounded lower line and a top line slant to the eyes which are a chartreuse colouring. Tail balances with the body and has a rounded tip. Unfortunately today his eyes and nose were in need of more presentation. His coat was close lying but it was very unsound and these were my reasons for withholding the award.

GRAND 1A CHAMPION; GR CC; Caughey INT CH HINCHKITZ MIDDLEMIST RED red colourpoint Persian just under three years old. Lovely bone structure and good weight. Fairly cobby body set low on the legs and with nicely rounded paws. Small ears set low on the side of the head, good width to the cheeks and his eyes are large and round showing a medium blue colouring. Short snub nose and good size leather and nostrils.

Bite just a touch undershot. Lovely red to the mask, ears and tail with the legs just a shade lighter in colouring. Tail is lightly furnished and balances with the body length.

GRAND 4C CHAMPION; GR CC; Fleming INT CH HOLLYANAS BEYOND THE MOON OF LYNAVIDS silver spotted tabby Bengal who is not yet two years old. Fairly large lad with a sleek body that is already quite muscular. His hind quarters re slightly higher than the shoulder. Medium length strong legs. Tail is thick and even with a rounded tip. Medium wedge and a nice breadth to the head that has slightly rounded contours and is slightly longer than wide with high set cheek bones. Slight curve from the nasal bridge to the nose leather and also from the bridge to the forehead to the bridge. Broad nose and full muzzle. Ears are medium and set to follow the contours of the head.

Gooseberry green eye colouring to almost round eyes. A small amount of tarnishing in some spots along his back, the rest of the coat showing a very good silver.

GRAND 5B CHAMPION; GR CC; Redmond INT CH JOYEUX JEWEL tortie ticked Asian of just over two years old. A lovely female with attitude but at the same time a wonderful temperament, she was a little Jekyll and Hyde! Her head is in proportion to her body size. She has a short wedge and lovely width at the cheekbones. Nicely rounded between the ears and a good depth from the top of the skull to the lower jaw. Small nose break and a straight nose. Level bite and firm chin. Medium size ears with nicely rounded tips. Her eyes are showing the top line slant and a rounded lower line. Her coat was beautifully evenly ticked, slightly cooler toned to her sides, red evident throughout. Short fine close lying coat of a most wonderful texture.

MAINE COON SILVER TABBY SERIES KITTEN MALE; 1 & BOB; McEvoy

BALLYSAILLEACH AODH LEON red silver classic tabby and white lad of five months old. He is very well grown for his age. Lovely body shape and good weight. Strong boned legs and nicely rounded paws. His ears are set quite high and a nice width apart with long tufts to the tips. High set cheek bones and cheeks are fairly full. Slight concave curve to the profile with a small bump to the nose. Eyes have a slightly oblique aperture and set. Nice breadth to the muzzle and the chin has a good depth and breadth. Level bite. Looking at the coat he could possibly be a red shaded but at this age this could still change, so it will be interesting to see how it develops as he reaches adulthood. White paws, chest and tummy. Some tabby markings on his legs but difficult to see anything of any strength on his body at this present time. Tail balances and is nicely furnished.

MAINE COON SILVER TABBY SERIES KITTEN FEMALE; 1 Wagner

FRIENDLYGHOSE SCARLETT MOON tortie silver classic tabby of eight months old. She is a very bonny female, I just felt at this age I would have preferred her larger. She has nice bone structure and adequate weight. Her ears are well set with good tufts and fairly full cheek bones. Slight concave curve to the profile and a level bite. Green colouring to the eyes which have a lovely shape and nice green colouring. Chin nearly level with the nice square muzzle. Soft texture to the coat and a lightly marked butterfly and oysters to the body. Good silver and nice black markings. She was a little nervous today and not showing at her best.

MAINE COON RED TABBY SERIES KITTEN; 1 & BOB; McClurg TITANIUMCAT CALI

tortie and white classic tabby kitten of five months old. Very nicely developed for her age with good bone structure and weight. Large ears set quite high with a nice width apart. Long tufts to the tips of her ears. High set cheek bones with the cheeks fairly full. Shallow concave curve to the profile. Eyes with a slightly oblique aperture and set showing a nice green colouring. Square muzzle and chin has a nice strength. White to her face, paws, chest and tummy. Lovely tabby markings and a well-defined m to the forehead. Tabby markings to her sides and a small butterfly marking on the shoulders. Tail is nicely furnished and balances with the body.

DEVON REX ADULT; BOB; Conchobhair & Wood GR CH & INT CH CHEREK NUTJEST ANY JINJANUT repeat.

SILVER BENGAL ADULT; BOB; Fleming INT CH HOLLYANAS BEYONDTHEMOON OF LYNAUIDS repeat.

CORNISH REX KITTEN; 1 & BOB; Howard IREGLOFO SHES THE NINTH WAVE

tortie female of just over six months old. Lovely feel to the body for this age. Slender legs with small oval paws. Head is almost a medium wedge with high cheek bones, head slightly longer than the width. Flat skull and a straight profile. I would have liked a little more strength to the muzzle. Ears set high on the head and showing a nice mussel-shell shape. Oval shaped eyes of a gold colouring. Level bite. Tail long and tapering with a good covering of wavy fur. Her coat is short with some density and a nice soft texture. A nice wave to her back and sides which extends a little way down her legs. Lovely temperament and easy to handle.

DEVON REX NEUTER; 1 PC & BOB; Leivshina IRIS VOM GABORLAND brown and white classic tabby of nearly six years old. A medium sized female who has a fairly short broad wedge with high set cheek bones, small whisker break. Moderately short wedge with a small break. Ears are large and nicely set they look better when she is relaxed and she tends to hold them up. Eyes are oval shaped and sloping towards the outer edge of the ear with a nice green colouring. A good covering of fur to a long tail. Super coat texture and wonderful wave, short and with a nice density. Clean white areas to set off the brown tabby patches. Lovely temperament and easy to handle.

SPHYNX NEUTER; PC & BOB; Harte NUDELOOK MISTER NOTORIOUS green eyed white lad of just over ten months old. Medium length body which has nice muscle development. Legs I proportion to the body and sturdy with the hind legs slightly longer than the front, long slender toes. Head has rounded contours and is slightly longer than wide. Prominent cheek bones and a nice whisker break. Skull is slightly rounded. Flat plane in front of the ears and a slight dip to the profile. Large ears that are set at a slight angle to the head. Lemon shaped eyes set nicely apart and gooseberry green in colour. Level bite, just a touch more strength to the chin for perfection. Fine down to the body, wonderful texture and very well presented.

LYKOI ASSESSMENT NEUTER; 1 M & BOB; Harte SHALNAVAZZ NIMOO this lad is around seventeen months old. Lovely slender body but with a very good weight. Medium length legs with oval shaped feet. Tail long and tapering and in balance with the body length. Modified wedge which is slightly longer than wide with rounded contours. His face is showing the wonderful werewolf look. A slight concave curve from the brow to the bridge of the nose. Rounded forehead and a slight whisker break. A good covering of guard hairs to the body. Soft texture and lying flat to the body. Super temperament and a pleasure to handle.

ASIAN SH TABBY ADULT; BOB; Redmond INT CH JOYEUX JEWEL repeat.

RED BURMESE KITTEN; 1 & BOB; Redmond JOYEUX DANCING FLAME just over five months old. Head is nicely proportioned to the body. She has a nice with at the cheeks and a blunt finish at the muzzle. Slightly rounded brow and a small nose break in profile, just a tiny bump present. Ears are medium to large in size and have a slight tilt forward. Eye colouring is still quite a muddy colour with a nice slant to the top line and a rounded lower line. Nicely developed bone structure and weight for her age. Oval paws and slender legs. Tail tapering to a rounded tip and in proportion to the body length. Short and fine coat with the depth of red stronger on the head and developing on the legs and body.

BROWN TORTOISESHELL BURMESE KITTEN; 1 & BOB; Redmond JOYEUX OPHELIA a bonny young lady of six months old. She is a good size and weight with a straight back from the shoulder to the rump. Neat oval paws on slender legs. Her tail is in proportion to her body. Short wedge with a nice a fair width at the cheek bones. Rounded top of head and a slightly rounded brow. Small nose break and a little bump to the nose. Firm chin and a level bite. Medium sized ears that slightly tilt forward. Eyes showing a slight golden yellow coming through and the shape is rounded at the bottom line with a slant to the top line. Lovely black and varying shades of red all over the body, legs and tail. A happy little female.
